

Our staff provides professional advice and assistance on obtaining eligible benefits under the:

- Veterans' Entitlement Act (VEA);
- Safety, Rehabilitation & Compensation Act (SRCA) and
- Military Rehabilitation & Compensation Act (MRCA)

In addition, the RSL State Branch Pensions, Advocacy and Wellbeing Service have advocates throughout Queensland who are:

Highly experienced in lodging claims under the

Veterans Entitlements Act (VEA), Safety, Rehabilitation & Compensation Act (SRCA) and Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act (MRCA);

- Caring and qualified to practice in their areas of expertise;
- Able to draw on a wealth of operational and broad-based peacetime experience; and
- Having served overseas and in the ADF for many years.

Services We Offer

The Hervey Bay RSL Sub-Branch's Pensions and Wellbeing Service covers disability pensions, compensation payments, associated allowances, income support payments and treatment available to entitled veterans and former serving members of the Defence Forces and their dependents.

Rimau KRAIT Commemoration Service 9 July 2023

On Sunday 9th July the Hervey Bay RSL Sub-Branch held a commemorative service for the World War 2 Operation Rimau at the TS KRAIT memorial, Dayman Park, Hervey Bay.

The service was conducted by the Hervey Bay Sub-Branch President, Brian Tidyman, before a crowd of over seventy people. The catafalque party was presented by the TS KRAIT Cadets and Rev'd Jeffrey Jarvis led the prayers for the service.

The names of all those who were members of the "Operation Rimau" were read out and a bell tolled for each and every one of them. The TS KRAIT memorial is a main feature of Dayman

Park and was erected in area that overlooks the waters to Fraser Island where the training took place for those who participated in Operation Rimau.



The Model of the H.M.S. VICTORY


made by Mr Denis Forster has now been placed on display in the foyer.

2 tablespoons ricotta cheese

1/2 teaspoon of lemon zest

Chopped fresh basil and

pepper for garnish

1 tablespoon marinara or pesto

1 tablespoon grated parmesan

Ingredients:

1 wholemeal naan

1 large egg

cheese

Directions:

Step 1

- ♦ Pre-heat oven to 220°.
- Coat a rimmed baking sheet with cooking spray.

Step 2

- Place naan on the prepared pan. Mix ricotta, marinara (or pesto) and lemon zest in a small bowl.
- Spread the mixture onto the naan, creating a well in the centre. Carefully crack egg into the well. Sprinkle with parmesan.
- Bake until naan is golden, the egg white is set and the cheese is melted, 8-10 minutes.
- Garnish with basil and pepper, if desired.
